

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS : SUSTAINABLE ADVENTURE TOURISM COMPETITION

Congratulations on your decision to enter this year's competition!

You could be on your way to EUROPE for an experience of a lifetime!!

1. Can any school or grade enter the competition?

No, the competition is open to South African schools that offer Tourism as a subject and only grade 11 Tourism learners may enter.

2. Can I enter on my own or must we enter as a pair?

The team consists of TWO learners. The two learners must do ONE research, submit it to the teacher who will then mark it using the assessment instrument attached. The teacher selects the winning proposal and submits it to GTTP-SA before 24 July 2015.

3. How must the proposal be typed?

Use font "ARIAL size 12", type on an A4 size paper, and use single spacing. Length: 4 x A4 pages typed. Please type on ONE side of the paper only.

4. What is the exact topic of the competition and what languages are allowed?

The topic is Sustainable Adventure Tourism. Learners from all 12 member countries research the same main topic to present in Europe. This is an international competition – you may only submit the proposal in ENGLISH.

5. Do we have to include a cover page, content page and a bibliography?

No, start with your heading. The proposal may only be 4 pages long.



6. May we include pictures in the proposal?

Pictures are not required, however, should you wish to include pictures, limit it to a maximum of TWO pictures in total.

7. How is the judging done?

For the first round, the adjudication panel in each province will select a provincial winner. These provincial winners will go through to the next round, where a national panel will select the overall winner.

8. What happens after the national winner has been announced.

The winning team and their teacher will be required to develop their proposal into a full case study consisting of learner activities and an educator's guide. They will then present this case study at the Global Travel and Tourism Learner and Teacher Conference in Europe at the end of November 2015. The GTTP-SA will provide support and assistance to the winning school.

9. What if the winning team cannot afford the costs involved in developing the case study and travel arrangements to Europe?

Don't worry! The GTTP-SA will assist you all the way.



10. How does our teacher submit our entry and what must be included?
